Our clients sometimes don't know what help or services are available to them, so drivers will be able to disseminate this information as and when it is needed. For example, Age UK offer a free tablet on loan to anyone elderly who is not connected to the internet and they also provide a dongle, which will allow internet access. Additionally they can find a "tech buddy" to help that person learn how to use the device.
